Again, it is narrated that the ship of Prophet Noah (a.s.) had escaped from the flood and that Prophet Moses (a.s.) had passed the Red Sea with his people on the Day of Ashura that comes on the tenth of Muharram.

The tragedy of Karbala, which took place on Ashura, will have passed 1400 years, though a bleeding wound continues in the heart of the Ummah. Hussein (r.a), who was sacrificed to the political ambitions of the cruel, the pain of our Hussein (r.a)'s murder, along with his companions, remains fresh in our consciences. We should learn from the atrocities that took place in Karbala, and why should you not use this incident for the discord of the Ummah.

We are witnessing that similar to such painful occurrence in our history, today is happening in especially Islamic regions and all other oppressed geographies. We regret to say that almost every day has become Ashura and everywhere has become Karbala.

Then, Prophet aid; "I am closer to Moses then you are." and He fast Himself on this day and encouraged others to do so.³ Accounting the other hadiths as well, fasting on the Day of Ashura together with a day before or after would grant us a great deed.

May our Lord grant us the opportunity to perform the Day of Ashura according to His will and to be eligible with the will according to the meaning of this day.
