On the other hand, there are those who do not even mention the war crimes committed.

Unfortunately, those who bring up this tragic situation and ask, "How many more people need to die for peace to be established?" often face hatred.

Helping these people in need of all kinds of assistance to sustain their lives and standing in solidarity with them is a common duty for all of us. Humanity is going through a great test in this regard.
